

Dear Model Speed Boat Association representative,

The Norwegian Model Power Boat Association is pleased to invite you to the 2006 NAVIGA World Championship for Model Power Boats. Below you will find the relevant information required to submit the Entry Forms for the national association that you represent.

Please follow the instructions carefully. As a confirmation of reception of the entries, all received entries from the national teams will be posted on [www.rcboat2006.com](http://www.rcboat2006.com) within May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2006.

**Organizers:**

Norwegian Model Power Boat Association in cooperation with Strandefjorden Fritidspark and NAVIGA.

**Location:**

Strandefjorden Fritidspark at Leira in Norway, about 10 km south of Fagernes.  
Latitude: 60,97113N, Longitude 9,28370E

**Time:**

Registration of teams starts **Sunday July 30<sup>th</sup>**. First day of competition is Tuesday August 1<sup>st</sup>. Price giving and closing ceremony will be on **Friday August 11<sup>th</sup>**.

**Automatic Lap Counting:**

An AMB Automatic Lap Counting system will be used for all races. Personal transponders will be accepted. The organizer will provide transponders for those who do not have personal transponders at a rate of EUR 10 for seniors and EUR 5 for juniors per class. Measurements (size) of the transponders can be found on [www.rcboat2006.com](http://www.rcboat2006.com), see the FAQ section. The transponders are expensive, and all participants must do their utmost not to lose them. We do therefore require the following:

- For FSR-V and FSR-O boats, please install a bracket for the transponder inside the boat. For carbon fibre hulls, installation of the transponder on top of the cowling will be accepted. The transponder can be installed through an 8 mm hole in the cowling with the safety clip on the back side. The transponders must be installed horizontally. Transponder brackets on the side or at the back of the boat will not be accepted.



- For hydros we strongly recommend to install two 15x15mm rubber shock absorbers on the left side of the hull 100mm apart. The organizer will provide transponder brackets which fits outside the number plates.

**Entry fee:**

The general entry fee for the World Championship is regulated by the NAVIGA rules, i.e EUR 15 for seniors and EUR 10 for juniors.

**Submission of Entry Forms.**

- All entries of competitors must be sent jointly at one time from each National Association with a valid NAVIGA membership. No registration of entries from individual persons will be accepted.
- One Entry Form must be filled in for each competitor. In addition, the team leader for each country must fill in a Summary Form.
- The submission of entries from the national association must include one Entry Form for each competitor, and the Summary Form. Both forms are enclosed or can be found on [www.rcboat2006.com](http://www.rcboat2006.com).
- In case personal transponders are used please remember to fill in the transponder number in the entry form.
- Submission via e-mail: The entries can be accepted via e-mail. Each entry form has to be signed by the competitor and the national association, then scanned and e-mailed as pdf format to the following email address:
